### VINTAGE

**GRAPE VARIETY** 100% Chardonnay

**APPELLATION** Cachapoal Valley

**HARVEST** Grapes are harvested from vineyards in the Cachapoal Andes Valley, known for its

**VINIFICATION** Mediterranean climate and high diurnal temperature variation, which helps retain fresh acidity in the grapes.

Undergoes a vinification process that emphasizes fruit expression and balanced acidity, with a portion of the wine seeing oak aging. The wine is made from 100% Chardonnay grapes, sourced from vineyards in the Cachapoal Andes Valley of Chile.

**ANALYSIS** Alcohol: 13,5%

**AGEING** In stainless steel tanks.

**TASTING NOTES** Pale and bright yellow with green hues. Aromas of tropical fruits, apricots and pears. Fresh with a good acidity and a persistent and elegant ending.
